

This study abroad initiative allows students from partner universities around the world to directly enroll for one semester, up to twenty credits at UTB. LOCATION

Cartagena de Indias is a fascinating place to study. Declared by UNESCO as a World Historical and Cultural Heritage site in 1984, Cartagena combines its rich history and culture with a large industrial complex that includes petrochemicals, bio-fuels and agro industry, as well as maritime ports, logistic centers and shipyards.

It has developed a large hotel infrastructure and hosts many international cultural events, such as the Hay Festival, an International Music Festival, the Cartagena Film Festival and many more. APPLYING TO UTB EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Applying to UTB exchange program

Application Deadlines:

Spring semester (February – June): October 30 Fall semester (August – December): April 30

Requirements:

- Application form: https://forms.gle/FQb628CZYKLgPqMF8
- One photo (passport size).
- Official transcripts.
- Passport copy.
- Motivation letter addressed to the academic program explaining why you want to come to UTB (written in Spanish).
- Letter from your academic director or advisor (a proof that he/she agrees with the exchange).
- Learning agreements: letter with the list of course you want to study in the UTB signed by your program director.
- Language Proficiency Certificate (minimum B2).
- International health insurance (could be sent before traveling).

Note: Exchange Students are responsible for air tickets, monthly living expenses, textbooks, insurance and other personal expenses. Once YOU SUBMIT the documentation, the UTB will be answering YOUR REQUEST within 15 days. With the acceptance letter, STUDENTS will receive visa and traveling information.


living expenses in cartagena
